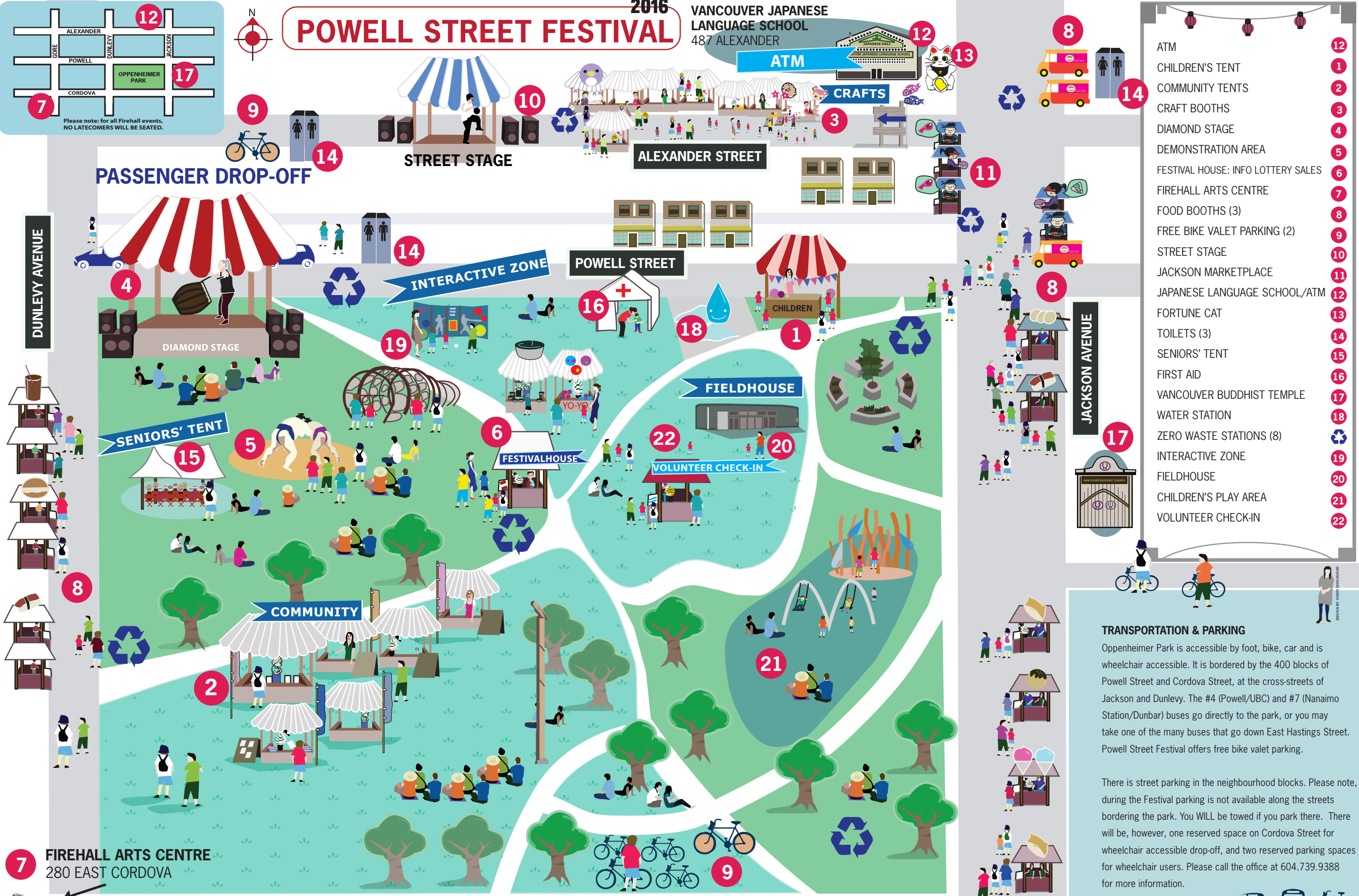

TRANSPORTATION & PARKING

Oppenheimer Park is accessible by foot, bike, car and is wheelchair accessible. It is bordered by the 400 blocks of Powell Street and Cordova Street, at the cross-streets of Jackson and Dunlevy. The #4 (Powell/UBC) and #7 (Nanaimo Station/Dunbar) buses go directly to the park, or you may take one of the many buses that go down East Hastings Street. Powell Street Festival offers free bike valet parking.

There is street parking in the neighbourhood blocks. Please note, during the Festival parking is not available along the streets bordering the park. You WILL be towed if you park there. There will be, however, one reserved space on Cordova Street for wheelchair accessible drop-off, and two reserved parking spaces for wheelchair users.
